

Prescription Information

This treatment plan contains important information regarding the medication that was prescribed to you by your doctor. The following includes: ingredient information, side effects, dosing instructions, proper storage, and other information important for you to know before starting treatment.

What are some things I need to know about this medication?

This medication is a custom compounded formula recommended for you by your prescriber. This medication is customized to your condition and made in a compounding pharmacy. If you have received a pump bottle, you may need to prime the bottle before using it. Press the pump several times to remove the excess air from the bottle. If that doesn't work still, insert a paperclip into the hole on the bottom of the bottle and press up firmly to move the piston up.

Prescription formula ingredients may include:

Triamcinolone Levocetirizine Dihydrochloride Ascorbic Acid (Vitamin C) in a Prescription Silicone Scar Gel

Ingredient Descriptions:

Triamcinolone is a topical steroid which may help reduce, flatten, and soften scars.

Levocetirizine may help reduce growth of scar tissue during the healing process and reduce itchiness associated with healing scars.

Vitamin C, or ascorbic acid, is added as a potent topical antioxidant which is a natural skin brightener that can lighten the pigment of a scar and help it blend in.

What is the best way to use this medication?

Apply a light coating of gel to clean, dry skin scar location, once daily at bedtime, or twice daily, as directed by your doctor. Wash hands after application. Follow your doctor's specific orders if you are unsure how to use the medication.

What should I tell my doctor before starting this medication?

Tell your doctor of any medication or ingredient allergies or sensitivities that you may have. Tell your doctor if you are allergic to any of the drugs in this formulation, as well as related drugs (vitamin C, ascorbic acid, acetyl hexapeptide, panthenol, vitamin B5, sodium hyaluronate, hyaluronic acid). Tell your doctor if you are pregnant, trying to get pregnant or breastfeeding.

Pregnancy & Breastfeeding

This compound has not been evaluated for use during pregnancy or breast feeding. If you are pregnant, breast feeding, or trying to become pregnant use this medication only at the discretion of your doctor.

What are the possible side effects of this medication?

Skin redness, skin irritation, burning, itching, peeling, thinning of your skin, blistering skin, or stretch marks. Stop using this medication and call your doctor at once if you have any of these less common side effects: blurred vision, seeing halos around lights, uneven heartbeats, mood changes, sleep problems (insomnia), or puffiness in your face.

How long until I see a desired effect from this medication?

It may take up to several weeks to months to see maximum results.

How should I store this medication?

If the product has arrived warm, wait 2 hours before using. Store this medication in a cool, dry environment, protected from light, at room temperature (68F-77F). Always make sure the container is tightly closed when not using the medication. Keep all medications in a safe place out of reach of pets and children.
